Significantly, such users are set to benefit from affordable 'send and receive' Outlook email functionality using the ultra-light Dmailer client. This allows a full Outlook experience on any PC, even if Outlook isn't pre-loaded. Dmailer's secure data container enables users to not only send and receive email, but to also work on offices files and browse the web with complete anonymity. A unique synchronization algorithm keeps all data synchronized once a user returns to their main PC.

Furthermore, Dmailer Mobile avoids the complications of transferring data to a new phone, or keeping it synchronized with a PC. All data is kept on the storage card, or SIM card with memory, of a user's mobile phone, and this card is kept synchronized with their PC and email server.
